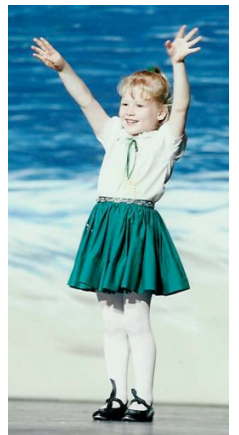

MacCulloch Dancers

Classes at the Navan/Orleans Branch are run under the direction of Heather MacCulloch Forbes. All directors and teachers are certified with the British Association of Teachers of Dancing. In addition to their teaching experience, they have all performed both locally and internationally with our performing troupe The MacCulloch Dancers

Rae MacCulloch founded the MacCulloch School of Dancing in the Fall of 1954. Over the years we have taught over 4000 students. We provide training in Highland and Traditional Celtic-Canadian Step Dancing. Our program caters to the individual needs of each of our students. We are welcoming new students, children and teens, boys and girls, from beginner to advanced levels in November 2011.

The MacCulloch Dancers celebrate Canada's rich multi-cultural identity through lively presentations of Scottish Folkloric and Canadian Step Dancing. The traditional dances of early Canadian settlers are danced to the lively tunes of Scotland's bagpipes and the Irish, French and Scottish fiddle and accordion. The music includes clogs, jigs, reels and hornpipes.

This group of young high school and university students has met with much success and recognition on the international scene. They have represented Canada in Disney World, Florida, Idaho and Utah, USA, Puerto Rico, the Republic of China, Spain, Mexico, Belgium, Bulgaria, The Netherlands, France, Scotland, Russia and Hungary. In August of 2005, the MacCulloch Dancers and the Sons of Scotland Pipe Band of Ontario, Canada had the great honor of performing for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth.

On July 31st, 2004, the MacCulloch School of Dancing celebrated 50 years of dance at the Glengarry Highland Games. Our founder, Rae MacCulloch led 504 students of the MacCulloch School of Dancing, past and present in a massed production of Highland & Step Dancing, breaking a Guinness World Record.

The MacCulloch dancers are proud to celebrate Scottish, Irish and French Canadian traditions both locally and abroad.
